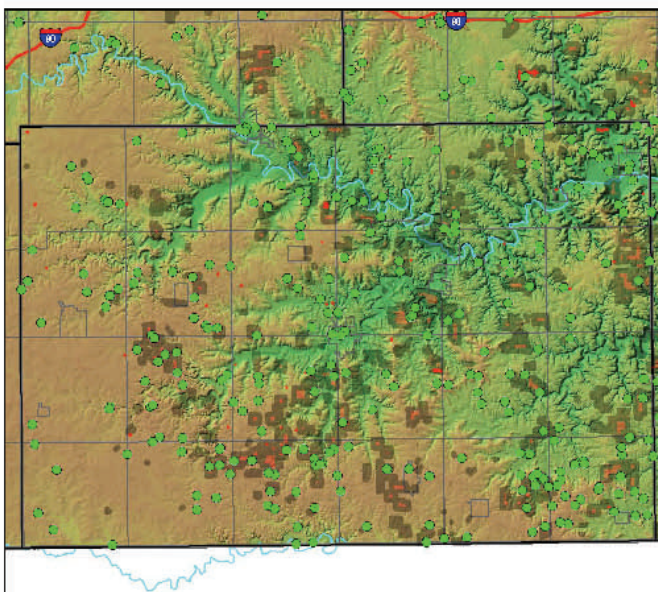

Outputs and Outcomes

Outputs: Five waterways (total of 9.79 acres) and one sediment basin were installed in 2010 using funding from FY2010.

Outcomes:
Water pollution reduction estimates for these projects
Reduction in TSS = 42 tons per year
Reduction in Soil Loss = 31 tons per year

* Remaining \$10,249.04 of FY10 funds are encumbered in contracts.
