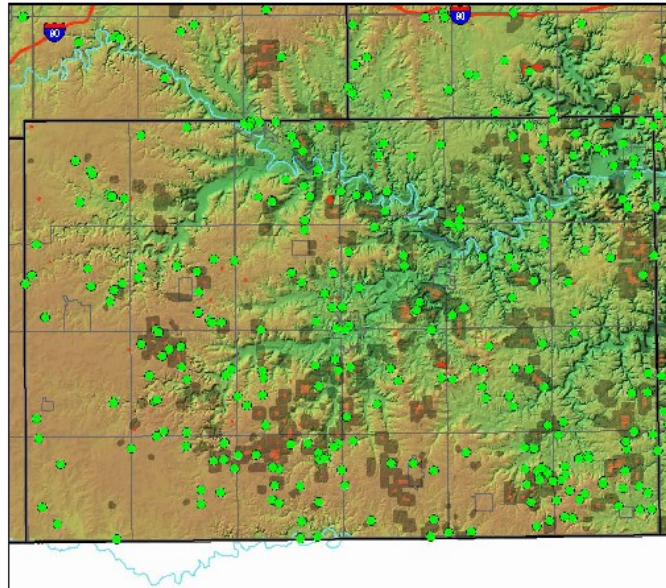

#### Outputs and Outcomes

Outputs: Four projects have contracts approved encumbering \$2,988.85. No projects were completed in 2013  
In 2014, 1 grassed waterway (1430' ), 1 water and sediment control basin, 1 terrace (1182'), and 2 well decommissionings were completed.

Outcomes:

Water pollution reduction estimates for projects completed:  
Reduction in Soil Loss = 26 T/acre/year



- Waterway needs are often evident after a rain event. A waterway's purpose is to:
- convey runoff from terraces, diversions or other water concentrations without causing erosion or flooding.
  - reduce gully erosion.
  - improve water quality.
